### *BSA Insurance Requirements:*

All vehicles MUST be covered by a public liability and property damage liability insurance policy. The amount of this coverage must meet or exceed the insurance requirement of the state in which the vehicle is licensed. (It is recommended, however, that the coverage limits are at least \$50,000(1), \$100,000(2) and \$50,000(3).
